1. Unified Workforce- Workforce Innovation Grant (WIG)

DESCRIPTION: LCEWD received workforce development funding from Colorado Dept. of Labor and Employment for Workforce Innovation Grants (WIG). The state (House Bill 21-1264) appropriated federal funds from the American Rescue Plan to support talent development. This includes funding to invest in programs and grants that support training for the unemployed and underemployed during times of substantial unemployment. The department was only able to fund a portion of the proposals received so the LCEWD requested funds from the BOCC to fund a few additional proposals. This was one of those additional proposals that the BOCC agreed to fund.
