2. Consent Agenda (Mark Johnston, Larimer County Economic and Workforce Dev.) 8:10am

- a. [Supportive Service Policy Update](#)
 - i. E.2 CTT reduced the amount of SS dollars available to Adults and Dislocated Workers who are NOT participating in training to a max of \$1000. The previous policy allowed up to \$5850. Overall EWD programming and budgets will begin to reduce in PY24 and PY25, prompting CTT to re-prioritize supportive service dollars to assist customers who are pursuing occupational skills development. Overages continue to be allowable with proper approvals.
 - ii. E.3 Youth supportive service cap increased from \$400 to \$600 per enrollment year. This increase was in response to years of holding at the same \$400 cap, in combination with overall increases in prices of goods and services. Overages continue to be allowable with proper approvals.
 - iii. F. Added clarifying language about where SS cap updates and decisions will be stored.
 - iv. E. Added 'Food' to items not allowable to be purchased with WIOA funds.
