### **Meeting was called to order at 12:00 pm by Steve Pietrafeso**

- Proposed Board Criteria Updates
  - Alex Danielson provided the following proposed board criteria updates:
    - Any FELONY offense (charge and/or conviction) in the last 5 years in which a firearm or deadly weapon was used or possessed, or the use of a deadly weapon was threatened.
    - Any FELONY arson charge and/or conviction within the past 5 years.
    - Any FELONY escape or unauthorized absence conviction in the last five years. The instant offense (charge and/or conviction) is a DF1 and involves the sale, possession with intent to sell, cultivation, dispensing or manufacturing of any controlled substance as defined in the Colorado Revised Statutes.
    - Any criminal act(s) resulting in the death, as defined by Colorado Revised Statutes, of a person.
    - Any criminal act(s) resulting in serious bodily injury, as defined by Colorado Revised Statutes, of a person, in the last 5 years.
    - Any FELONY offense (charge/conviction) that involves kidnapping, strangulation, habitual domestic violence and/or stalking, in the last 5 years.
    - Any out of county diversion referral, referred for placement by any Court other than the 8th Judicial District that meets any full Board criteria.
    - Recommended for review due to their history or circumstances by Community Corrections staff or Judge, or has been convicted of a crime that gained special notoriety or faced significant community resistance.
    - Any parole referral, referred for placement by any Court other than the 8th Judicial District that meets any full Board criteria.
    - Receives a felony arrest while under the supervision of the LCCC program within the last 5 years.
    - Is serving a sentence for a Class 1 or 2 felony; a Class 3 felony with a sentence of over fifteen years or an unclassified crime with a sentence of over fifteen years.
      - Additions to Criteria:
      - Re-Screens
      - Client is being reviewed after an escape, termination or reject after accept by the program and the Court has requested the case be RE-SCREENED.

- Assault on Law Enforcement
- Client is being screened on a FELONY conviction of an assault of a peace officer or first responder.
- Cases that are dismissed before going to a disposition.
- Clients that are requesting to remain at LCCC as a Condition of Parole who were seen by the Board for the Transition review do not need to be reviewed by the Board for a second time.
- Any victim who wishes to speak at the Board, that is a non-criteria case.
- Advisory Board members asked for the following data
  - Accept and reject rates for the board
  - Accept and reject rates for the program
  - Reject codes used for the board
  - Reject codes used for the program
  - Number of clients convicted of a felony in the last 3 years while under community corrections supervision
  - Number of felony escapes in the last 3 years
- The presentation has been attached to the meeting minutes
- A survey will be sent out to vote on the board criteria updates.
