1. Discussion Item: Sworn Deputy Compensation

Item Description: The Sheriff's Office is experiencing difficulties hiring and retaining a qualified diverse work force. Many factors contribute to these issues to include the current policing climate as well as our ability to compensate new and existing deputies. Agencies around us to include Loveland, Ft. Collins, and Timnath continue to raise their compensation for their officers making it impossible for the sheriff's office to compete. The sheriff's office has worked with county HR to study this issue and develop strategies to address this issue. During this work session the problem will be discussed as well as presenting the commissioners with options to help the sheriff's office be able to attract and retain a qualified and diverse work force.
