## WORK SESSION

### 1. Discussion Item: Sheriff's Office Emergency Services Facility Needs Update

Item Description: The County worked with The Architects' Studio to complete a facility needs study for Sheriff's Office Emergency Services toward the end of 2021, which was shared with the Board of County Commissioners early in 2022. To meet the longer-term needs, a structure of about 30K sq ft is needed. The current facility location at 1303 N. Shields in Fort Collins is in the flood plain, requiring significant investment to redevelop and expand that site. Instead, the County has been looking for a property of about 12 acres with good access to the Poudre Canyon. The Sheriff's Office and Facilities have connected with other agencies, hoping to form partnerships that could reduce the capital investment for the County and enhance operations for Emergency Services and its potential partners.

The project team will provide an overall update on the property search, partnerships being explored, and upcoming grant funding the County will pursue to help reduce the overall project cost.
