3. Amend the table of allowed uses in Article 3.2.6. Table of Allowed Principle Uses (Rural) and Article 3.2.7. Table of Allowed Uses – (Urban) to eliminate oil and gas facilities from certain zone districts to align with the proposed Article 11.0. Oil and Gas Facilities regulations.
