CALL TO ORDER – 8:34 a.m.

AGENDA REVIEW

1. Laurie Stolen called the meeting to order, reviewed the agenda, and asked for those present to introduce themselves.

STANDING AGENDA ITEMS

1. Ryan Barstow asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the 7/26/21 meeting. Madison Krumwiede made the motion, seconded by Al Anderson, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

DISCUSSION/DECISIONS

1. Ryan explained the new agenda management system being implemented by Larimer County and demonstrated the new location for CAC agendas, minutes, and meeting materials which can be found [here](#). Materials will still be sent out to members via email; however, the new location where they'll be published will replace the member portal on the BHS website that was used to post materials previously.
2. Members then worked together as a group to finish the client journey mapping activity, completing scenarios #4 - 6.
3. Due to the absence of necessary members, the group decided to push the Gap Scenarios and Community Advocacy Discussion items to the next meeting in September.
4. Ryan discussed the upcoming application process for open CAC seats taking place in September. There will be 7 seats up for a 12/2021 appointment, applications for which will be accepted via the Larimer County Boards and Commissions website [here](#). Three of the open seats are currently unoccupied and the following member's term limits end 11/30/21 - Alison Dawon, Patrick Dillon, Leslie Maldonado, and Ryan Walter. Current members can choose to reapply if they'd like to seek reappointment.
5. Ryan said he received a couple requests from members to change the day/time of CAC meetings and asked members if they'd like to open a discussion to do so. Members decided that since new members will be joining the committee in December, it would be better to wait until they join before opening the discussion. However, members asked for a poll to be sent out to determine preference for CAC meeting location(s) after members present stated they'd prefer to keep meetings in Fort Collins and not rotate to Loveland.
