Description: Larimer on the Move is an effort consisting of an update to the 2017 Larimer County Transportation Master Plan and the development of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan under the federal Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program. The County will be adopting a "Vision Zero" policy as part of this program in an effort to significantly reduce fatalities and serious injuries on our county road system.

Feedback Sought: We've had a successful summer of public input ranging from surveys and online map comments to various in-person outreach events throughout the County. The draft existing and future conditions reports along with the proposed vision and goals have been developed. We will start our second phase of public input the second week of November. We would like the Planning Commission and County Commissioners input on the initial compilation of public input and the proposed vision and goals for the Larimer on the Move program.
