A petition filed by the City of Thornton for a Floodplain Project Review for construction of a 42-inch underground pipeline to move raw water from Larimer County to the City of Thornton under Boxelder Creek in the FEMA and Best Available Zone AE (Floodway) Floodplain Overlay District at the following location to wit: Section 27, Township 8 North, Range 68 West, Larimer County, Colorado, also known as parcel 8827110003.
2. A petition filed by Jim Birdsall for a Conditional Letter of Map Revision for a new development which includes a proposed bridge, proposed bank stabilization at multiple locations, proposed detention ponds, detention pond outfalls, and earthwork (excavation and fill) within the City of Fort Collins that impacts Larimer County parcels. The development is within the Boxelder Creek FEMA and Best Available Zone AE (Floodway) and Zone AE (Flood Fringe) at the following location to wit: Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 68 West, Larimer County, Colorado, also known as parcels 8716406003, 8716400066, 8716400010, and 8716428001. A petition filed by the Town of Timnath for a Conditional Letter of Map Revision for improvements to County Road 5 between Harmony Road and Weitzel Street including a bridge replacement over the Cache la Poudre River, road realignment, road widening, and installation of culverts under County Road 5 in the FEMA and Best Available Zone AE (Floodway) and Zone AE (Flood Fringe) Floodplain Overlay Districts at the following location to wit: Sections 2 and 3, Township 6 North, Range 68 West, Larimer County, Colorado.
